

CARBON WALL TILE



To create a carbon wall, you can assemble the wall tiles into modules that are versatile enough to be assembled into various...



Its presence in a space creates a warm and inviting atmosphere. The earthy-ness evokes a sense of tranquility, making it a popular choice in interior design.



Carbon Wall Tiles can last upto 70 years if maintained porperly. These are the series of measures for its maintenance and care.

LAYING: There will be dimensional variations both in thickness and right angles as it is handmade. Variations will have to be adjusted accordingly by the mason to attain the desired layout.

APPLICATION: Carbon Tiles are recommended for horizontal and vertical surfaces in indoor spaces. Usage

of these tiles in outdoor open areas may lead to a weathered appearance and loss of polish.

CAUTION: These tiles are not recommended for areas where there will be frequent spillage of oil or

masalas such as kitchen countertops, and heavy wet areas like bathrooms.

ROUTINE: For daily maintenance, mop with normal water with attention to changing the water often. Please do not use harsh cleaning chemicals.

MORE INFORMATION

Q: How will my custom-made design be implemented?

A: Once the design is finalised and order placed, we will recommend our execution partners to assist with the implementation of your own Carbon Wall. In case you have your own execution team, we will send one of our execution partners to overlook the design implementation for support.

Q: What is the required lead time?

A: Upon confirmation, to use Carbon Wall Tiles on a wall with standard dimensions, the delivery will be done in 30 to 40 days. On walls with exceptional dimensions, the lead time may go up to 60 days.

Q: Will the joint lines be visible once the tiles are laid?

A: Yes, the joint lines will be visible as the tiles are laid in very close vicinity with a 1-2mm gap for the grouting material, which is necessary to keep tiles intact along with the bottom bedding material.

Q: Is it safe to use Carbon Wall Tiles?

A: Yes, it is perfectly safe as it is made of natural materials like marble chips, marble powder and stone dust.
